It is my pleasure to recommend Jessica Fisch, RN, for a New Graduate Registered Nurse position. I had the opportunity to serve as Jessica's senior preceptor during her 168-hour telemetry preceptorship at Good Samaritan Hospital.

Throughout the preceptorship, Jessica consistently demonstrated professionalism, accountability, and a strong commitment to patient-centered care. She routinely arrived well before the start of her shift to review patient charts, laboratory values, medications, and telemetry rhythms so she could begin the day fully prepared. Her initiative, preparation, and strong work ethic were evident throughout the entire preceptorship experience.

Jessica actively sought feedback and consistently applied it to improve her practice. She welcomed coaching, asked thoughtful questions, and demonstrated noticeable growth in her confidence, prioritization, time management, clinical judgment, and documentation skills throughout the rotation. She independently completed daily rhythm strip analyses and accurately identified clinically significant rhythm changes, including multiple heart blocks and conduction abnormalities. While managing her patient assignment, she consistently completed thorough and timely charting, communicated abnormal findings to the RN and telemetry technician, and demonstrated a strong understanding of how rhythm interpretation, patient assessment findings, documentation, and clinical interventions are connected.

In addition to her technical skills, Jessica communicated effectively with patients, families, nurses, providers, and ancillary staff. She established rapport quickly, advocated appropriately for her patients, and maintained a calm and professional demeanor even during challenging situations. Her ability to balance clinical responsibilities while maintaining compassionate patient care was consistently evident.

Jessica possesses the qualities I value most in a new graduate nurse: a strong work ethic, eagerness to learn, accountability, professionalism, compassion, and dedication to safe patient care. Based on my experience working alongside her, I am confident she will be successful in a nurse residency program and become a valuable member of any nursing team.
